

Lighter Safety Standards and Regulations

As a best practice, BIC recommends purchasing lighters with third-party compliance verification

Federal Law: Consumer Product Safety Commission's – Safety Standard for Cigarette Lighters (16 CFR, Part 1210) Mandatory Standard

Cigarette lighters with import or wholesale cost under \$2.25 and all novelty lighters, must be child-resistant.

American Society for Testing and Materials' Standard Consumer Safety Specification for Lighters (ASTM F400-10) Responsible manufacturers should always manufacture in accordance with industry standards:

- > Flame Height / Flame Consistency / Proper Extinguishment
- > Proper Fuel Level / Structure Integrity

Retailer Restrictions

- > FDA Family Smoking Prevention and Tobacco Control Act
- > Be sure to consult your local laws, regulations, ordinances (e.g., giving away a lighter)
